

Residency in Cyprus: EU, EEA, and Swiss Nationals

Introduction

Cyprus is a welcoming destination for EU, EEA, and Swiss nationals looking to live, work, or settle in the country. As a member of the European Union, Cyprus offers straightforward residency options for Union citizens. Right of Residence for Up to Three Months

EU, EEA, and Swiss citizens can reside in Cyprus for up to three months without any special formalities. To qualify, you must hold a valid passport or national identity card.

This right also extends to:

- Family members who are EU, EEA, or Swiss nationals
- Dependents with valid identification

During this initial period, no registration or additional documentation is required.

Right of Residence for More Than Three Months

If you plan to stay in Cyprus for longer than three months, certain conditions apply. You must provide proof of your identity and demonstrate one of the following:

- Employment – either as an employee or self-employed individual

- Sufficient resources – enough funds to support yourself and your family without relying on the Cypriot social assistance system, along with comprehensive health insurance coverage

Access to Employment

EU, EEA, and Swiss nationals, as well as their eligible family members, have full rights to work in Cyprus. This includes both employed positions and self-employment opportunities.

Registration Certificate (MEU1)

All EU, EEA, and Swiss nationals intending to reside in Cyprus longer than three months must apply for a Registration Certificate (MEU1).
